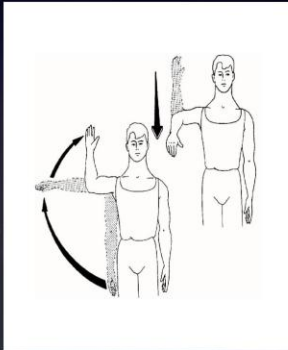
Telerehabilitation

Allows you to do therapy 7 days per week without having to leave your home. It provides you access to therapists via webcam, and includes interactive games.



Shoulder - Internal/External Rotation

With your arm at your palm facing in, raise arm straight out to height. Bending the raise your hand up towards ceiling, then down towards floor, keeping your from moving.



About the Study:

- All equipment provided and set-up in your home at no cost to you or your insurance. Complete training provided
- 7 visits to UCI over 3 months with a brain MRI scan
- 7 days/week for 4 weeks
- Access to physical / occupational therapists via webcam

Purpose of Study:

- To investigate how home telerehabilitation therapy for the arm and hand can improve function after stroke
- A second goal is to see if a drug that increases brain dopamine further improves the value of telerehabilitation
